 $2020 \sim$ "Tommasi has 110 years experience growing Cabernet Sauvignon in Toscana. The tradition continues here in Maremma, in Toscana's southwest corner. This 60/40 mix of Sangiovese / Cabernet Sauvignon comes off the Pitigliano estate, with soils rich in calcium carbonate tufa. The wine is stainless fermented and aged 1 year in large 65hL Slavonian casks. Ample sticky and blocky tannins frame ripe cherry, sarsaparilla, and perfumed raspberry across the medium bodied palate. Rustic-hewn, this would be best with braised meats / root veg." - Treve Ring - Gismondi on Wine, Feb/2024

Poggio al Tufo is a 66-hectare estate in the south of Tuscany, owned by the Tommasi family, one of the world's foremost Amarone producers, founded in 1902. The wine is grown in the Rompicollo vineyard, which has southern exposure, volcanic soils and is densely-planted to 6,500 vines per hectare.
