- Colour: Bright, deep ruby red.
- Aroma: Complex and elegant with a rich bouquet of black fruits like plums, cherries and blackberries. Followed up by red fruit aromas, balsamic and spicy nuances with a hint of dark chocolate.
- Taste: It is full-bodied and austere on the palate, with rich tannins and a very long, splendidly fresh finish.
- Food: Perfect with braised meats, stews, and game. Ideal with grilled red meats and cheeses.

2012 ~ 94 Points. "The 2012 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Riserva Ca' Florian holds nothing back, exploding from the glass with a massive wave of medicinal blackberries and cherries dipped in dark chocolate, complemented by autumnal and balsamic spices. It's weighty and dense in the mouth, showing amazing concentration and persistence, as a more savory display of tart wild berries mixes with sour citrus. Throughout this heady display, a core of zesty acids maintains balance. You don't feel it until the very end, but there's a coating of fine wood tannin that is only revealed as the Ca' Florian's glycerol-textured fruits slowly fade. Open the 2012 now for all of its upfront appeal, or cellar it to explore its unseen depths – either way, it's quite a wine." - Antonio Galloni's Vinous, Feb/2021

2012 ~ 94 Points. "After a relatively mild winter, the 2012 season was one of the driest of the past few years. Rains at the end of August and a good September balanced the vintage, which was relatively low in terms of yields. Ca' Florian shows a relatively modern style, focused on filigree precision and displaying great definition of cherry fruit combined with bay leaf, myrtle and chocolate. The elegant finish arrives after almost-silky tannins and well-integrated zesty acidity." - Decanter, May/2021

2012 ~ 93 Points. "This special late-release blend of 75% Corvina, 20% Corvinone and 5% Rondinella (with only 9,000 bottles made) shows the sweetness of the hot vintage and the appassimento process on the one hand and the spiciness of bottle age on the other. The bouquet is rooted in tertiary aromas of dried plum, prune, campfire ember and powdered licorice. In other words, the wine is sweet and savory at the same time, and that is really something only Amarone can pull off." - Robert Parker's Wine Advocate, Dec/2021

OTHER INFO

This is the first vintage release of the single vineyard Amarone Riserva "Ca' Florian". Amarone Riserva "Ca' Florian" is made with selected grapes from one of the oldest vineyards that the Tommasi family owns. The Riserva designation comes from 4 years of aging in wooden barrels (Slavonian Oak casks) as required by law.
