OTHER INFO

Grapes are grown in a high hill climate, humid and rainy in the cooler season, with high ventilation and luminosity and significant temperature excursions. Grapes are hand picked during October and destemmed. Fermentation occurs at a controlled temperature of 25°C in stainless steel vats, with a 20-21 days long maceration, using patented selected indigenous yeasts. About 80% of the wine then matures in stainless steel tanks, while about 20% matures in French oak barriques for 8-10 months).
