TASTING NOTES

- Colour:** Deep maroon.
- Aroma:** On the nose, ripe red berry fruit aromas come to the fore enhanced by more complex characters coming from the oak ageing.
- Taste:** Fresh and silky on the palate with good volume and excellent structure.
- Food:** Serrano-ham-based tapas, fatty fish such as salmon, or grilled pork chops.

AWARDS & ACCOLADES

2015 ~ 95 Points. "A sweet raspberry nose that is so fresh and pure. Electric tension between the fruit, tannins and acidity, and a great texture too. A stunning wine that redefines what Spanish red wine can be. Drink now." - James Suckling, Jul/2017

2015 ~ 91 Points. "Beautiful and delicate nose showing fresh mangoes and hints of cream. Full-bodied with a candied-fruit, watermelon and apple character. Drink now." - James Suckling, Dec/2016

2013 ~ 90 Points. "They reduced the amount of oak for the 2013 Losada, trying to show more the Mencia character in the wine. The nose denotes more freshness, it doesn't seem as concentrated as in previous vintages, and the palate also shows better balance. I like the direction this cuvee is going within the house style. There were 92,428 bottles and 300 magnums produced." - Robert Parker's the Wine Advocate, Apr/2016

OTHER INFO

Mencia grapes are selected from vineyards located in different areas of Bierzo where careful vine-growing, the right altitude and good exposure enable perfect ripening of the grapes. The vineyards are planted in different soil-types, most of which are either made up of fragmented slate (such as in Campo and Molinaseca) or clay (as in Valtuille and Villadecanes).
