TASTING NOTES

- Colour:** Deep maroon.
- Aroma:** On the nose, ripe red berry fruit aromas come to the fore enhanced by more complex characters coming from the oak ageing.
- Taste:** Fresh and silky on the palate with good volume and excellent structure.
- Food:** Serrano-ham-based tapas, fatty fish such as salmon, or grilled pork chops.

2015 ~ 90 Points. "This my kind of big, red wine, rich and juicy but mineral laden and full of red fruits. It's rich and warm with meaty, smoky, savoury notes. The palate is big and warm but juicy with spicy, vanilla, savoury, black cherry, plum, smoky tobacco and licorice flavours. A blockbuster red you should decant and serve with roasted meats. OTHER INFO

Mencia grapes are selected from vineyards located in different areas of Bierzo where careful vine-growing, the right altitude and good exposure enable perfect ripening of the grapes. The vineyards are planted in different soil-types, most of which are either made up of fragmented slate (such as in Campo and Molinaseca) or clay (as in Valtuille and Villadecanes).
