It was established in 1850 by English migrant Frank Potts, who arrived in South Australia on the Buffalo in 1836. The vineyards are situated on the flood plains of the Bremer River, which runs parallel to Langhorne Creek. Bleasdale is solely owned and operated by fourth and fifth generation members of the Potts family.



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
