Tenuta Caseo is the new addition to the Tommasi Family Estates portfolio, it is located in the upper Valle Versa in the territory of Oltrepo Pavese, in Lombardy. The Caseo estate is unique for its sun exposure, south-southwest, and the composition of the soil with a high clay content, along with a good presence of active limestone, perfect for making wines of extraordinary elegance as Pinot Noir.

The vineyards are cultivated in accordance with the guidelines on agriculture at low environmental impact; cordon trained and guyot are the systems used to grow vines respecting rigid agronomic practices to maintain low yields and obtain high quality grapes.
