Colour: Deep ruby colour

Aroma: Seductive aromas of luscious black cherries mixed with cloves, spice and a touch of vanilla.

Taste: Well-rounded and supple cherry and plum flavour with a bit of earthiness. Soft tannins and a smoky and black tea-tobacco note finishes this full flavoured wine deliciously.

Food: Pork roast, duck breast, marinated skirt steak, a fall glazed ham, lentil curry, mushroom bruschetta or a beautiful grilled salmon steak.
