Taste:	Well balanced with good structure and length, and intense berry fruit and spice flavours.

Lovely balance in the mouth, expect sweet ripe fruit and lofted acidity. It's medium-bodied, supple and delicious. 2021 ~ "A Tuscan blend of sangiovese and cabernet sauvignon (60/40), grown in calcium carbonate-rich tufa soils in Maremma. Fermented in stainless steel vats and matured for a year in 65 hL Slavonian oak casks, it opens with delicate florals, red cherries, and raspberries layered with green leafy herbs and a hint of savoury spices. With a slightly soft and lean palate for these varieties, this medium bodied red offers a mix of sweet and sour fruit framed by somewhat rustic, drying tannins on the palate." - HJ Cha - Gismondi on Wine, Jan/2025

Poggio al Tufo is a 66-hectare estate in the south of Tuscany, owned by the Tommasi family, one of the world's foremost Amarone producers, founded in 1902. The wine is grown in the Rompicollo vineyard, which has southern exposure, volcanic soils and is densely-planted to 6,500 vines per hectare.



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
