TASTING NOTES

- Colour:** Dark cherry red with purple edges.
- Aroma:** Intense and complex bouquet showing vibrant aromas of plum, tobacco, liquorice and hints of violet.
- Taste:** Broad flavours of blueberries, plums and blackberries. Vibrant and chewy, this is a wine of purity and depth. Well-balanced with good acidity and tannins.
- Food:** Aged Cheese, game, grilled red meats, prime rib roasts, rich stews.

AWARDS & ACCOLADES

2023 ~ 94 Points. "... It's juicy, ripe and approachable, a little showier and headier, not quite reaching 14% alcohol but almost. This year, it has some 10% Garnacha in the bottled blend, some of it mixed with Tempranillo and some of it on its own. They are planting more Garnacha for the future. It feels like a very classical old-time Ribera del Duero wine, with elegant rusticity that I love. It's perfumed and floral with notes of decayed flowers. Twenty percent of the wine matured in barrels while the rest matured in oak vats, for some 14 months. The tannins are polished, and it feels like the time in bottle has done it good; the PSI tannins usually need time..." - Luis Guti  rez - Robert Parker's Wine Advocate, Jul/2026

2023 ~ 92-94 Points. "The 2023 PSI brings together fruit from 12 villages, mostly Gumiel de Mercado and Villatuelda in the Soria sector of Ribera del Duero. The project began in 2007 with the recovery of neglected vineyards, now totaling 200 hectares across about 700 parcels, 25% of which are estate-owned. Garnet colored, it opens with pine and herbal notes, then red fruit—cherry and a touch of plum. The palate shows fine-grained tannins, a midweight texture and detailed fruit. The bottle will reveal the Soria character in the interplay of fine tannins and acidity." - Joaqu  n Hidalgo - Antonio Galloni's Vinous, Jun/2025

2023 ~ 91 Points. "A well-balanced red, with fresh focus, this offers flavors of ripe black and red currant fruit, plus accents of mountain herbs, stone, smoked paprika and rose hip married to fine, taut tannins and plum skin acidity. This is structured, with good tension, but still accessible whether sipped or paired with food." - Alison Napjus - Wine Spectator, Oct/2026

OTHER INFO

Peter Sisseck, after having established Pingus as a benchmark for greatness in Spanish wines, has embarked on PSI, a wine meant to capture the soul of Ribera del Duero. In collaboration with partner Pablo Rubio, Sisseck intends to do this by harnessing the passion of the region's growers who have, for far too long, lacked the tools, capital and vision to make wine that is truly "theirs." The idea was born of Peter's passionate belief in organic and biodynamic farming as well as his gratitude to the region for giving a young Danish winemaker the opportunity to make Pingus, arguably Spain's most coveted wine. When making PSI, there will be experimentation with winemaking as the project develops, but the primary concept is to eschew many of the modern techniques used in the region today.



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
