Taste:	Flavours of fresh lemon and pear are braced by firm acidity and a hint of dusty minerality. Clean and brisk, offering refreshing lift and cut to the dry, focused finish.
Food:	Shellfish, white fish, roasted duck.

It has a gorgeous nose of caramelized citrus, orange blossom, flowers, and spice to go with a medium-bodied, layered, vibrant style on the palate. Brought up all in stainless steel, with plenty of lees contact, this pure, precise, yet still concentrated white is seriously impressive.
